Breastfeeding: the method of feeding a baby with milk directly from the mother’s breast (Bristow, 2012). Breastfeeding is the normal way of providing young infants with the nutrients they need for healthy growth and development (WHO, 2013). Colostrum, the yellowish, sticky breast milk produced at the end of pregnancy (WHO, 2013).
