The relatively recent Dissociated Control Theory of Hypnosis attempts to explain the hypnotic response via the association between 'executive' control and the lower control subsystems. The theory suggests that when the executive (higher) control is disabled, the subject relies on the lower control subsystem.

## The State Versus the Non-State Debate - Theories of Hypnosis

The two main theories that explain the hypnotic trance are referred to as state and non-state theories. They respectively argue that hypnosis is either a dissociative state or a relaxed state that accepts suggestion.
