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### Medicare Prospective Payment And The

A Prospective Payment System (PPS) is a method of reimbursement in which Medicare payment is made based on a predetermined, fixed amount. The payment amount for a particular service is derived based on the classification system of that service (for example, diagnosis-related groups for inpatient hospital services). CMS uses separate PPSs for reimbursement to acute inpatient hospitals, home health agencies, hospice, hospital outpatient, inpatient psychiatric facilities, inpatient ...

Section 1881(b)(14) of the Social Security Act requires a bundled PPS for renal dialysis services furnished to Medicare beneficiaries for the treatment of ESRD effective January 1, 2011.

### End Stage Renal Disease (ESRD) Prospective Payment System ...

Section 10501 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010 modified how payment is made for Medicare services furnished at Federally qualified health centers (FQHCs). On October 1, 2014, FQHCs began transitioning to a prospective payment system (PPS) in which Medicare payment is made based on a national rate which is adjusted based on the location of where the services are furnished.

### FQHC PPS | CMS

Section 1886 (d) of the Social Security Act (the Act) sets forth a system of payment for the operating costs of acute care hospital inpatient stays under Medicare Part A (Hospital Insurance) based on prospectively set rates. This payment system is referred to as the inpatient prospective payment system (IPPS).
