### The Postmodern Condition by Jean-Francois Lyotard. 1979

The Postmodern Condition is about the dominance of scientific knowledge over that of narrative, and the related death of meta-narratives. The performativity principle underlined by late capitalism plays a crucial role in the subordination of the narrative form simply because narration is not instrumental in creating capital.

I define postmodern as incredulity toward metanarratives. This incredulity is undoubtedly a product of progress in the sciences: But that progress in turn presupposes it. To the obsolescence of the metanarrative apparatus of legitimation corresponds, most notably, the crisis of metaphysical philosophy and of the university institution which in the past relied on it.

In *The Postmodern Condition*, Lyotard introduced the idea of postmodernism as something that extended well beyond the arts, into society, politics, sociology and even the psychology of the human condition. The work was published in 1979 as a retaliation against the large meta-narratives of modernism.
