It's not safe for the child whose parents choose not to vaccinate—and it's really not safe for the infants or people with immune problems who cannot be vaccinated, who need vaccinated people around them to keep them well. Vaccines are a medical treatment, and like any medical treatment, they can have risks and side effects.

Why we need to make it harder for parents to refuse ...

Unvaccinated at age 15–59 months: Administer 1 dose. Previously unvaccinated children age 60 months or older who are not considered high risk: Do not require catch-up vaccination; For other catch-up guidance, see Table 2. Special situations. Chemotherapy or radiation treatment:
